

NOTICE OF EAW AVAILABILITY

The Buffalo-Red River Watershed District (BRRWD) proposes the development of the Glyndon East Tributary Restoration Project in Clay County, Minnesota. The project requires an Environmental Assessment Worksheet (EAW) because it will change or diminish the course, current, or cross-section of one acre or more of a public water (Subp. 27). Project components along the Glyndon East Tributary include the establishment of expanded permanent vegetated buffers, the installation of sediment control best management practices (BMPs), and stream restoration. The project is located along the Glyndon East Tributary in the Townships of Moland, Glyndon, and Riverton (Clay County). The project is a cooperative undertaking between the BRRWD, State, and Federal agencies.

An EAW has been prepared and is available for review on the BRRWD website (www.brrwd.org). Written comments concerning the EAW will be received until July 22, 2021. The comments shall address the accuracy and completeness of the material contained in the EAW, potential impacts that may warrant further investigation before the project is commenced, and the need for an Environmental Impact Statement on the proposed project.
