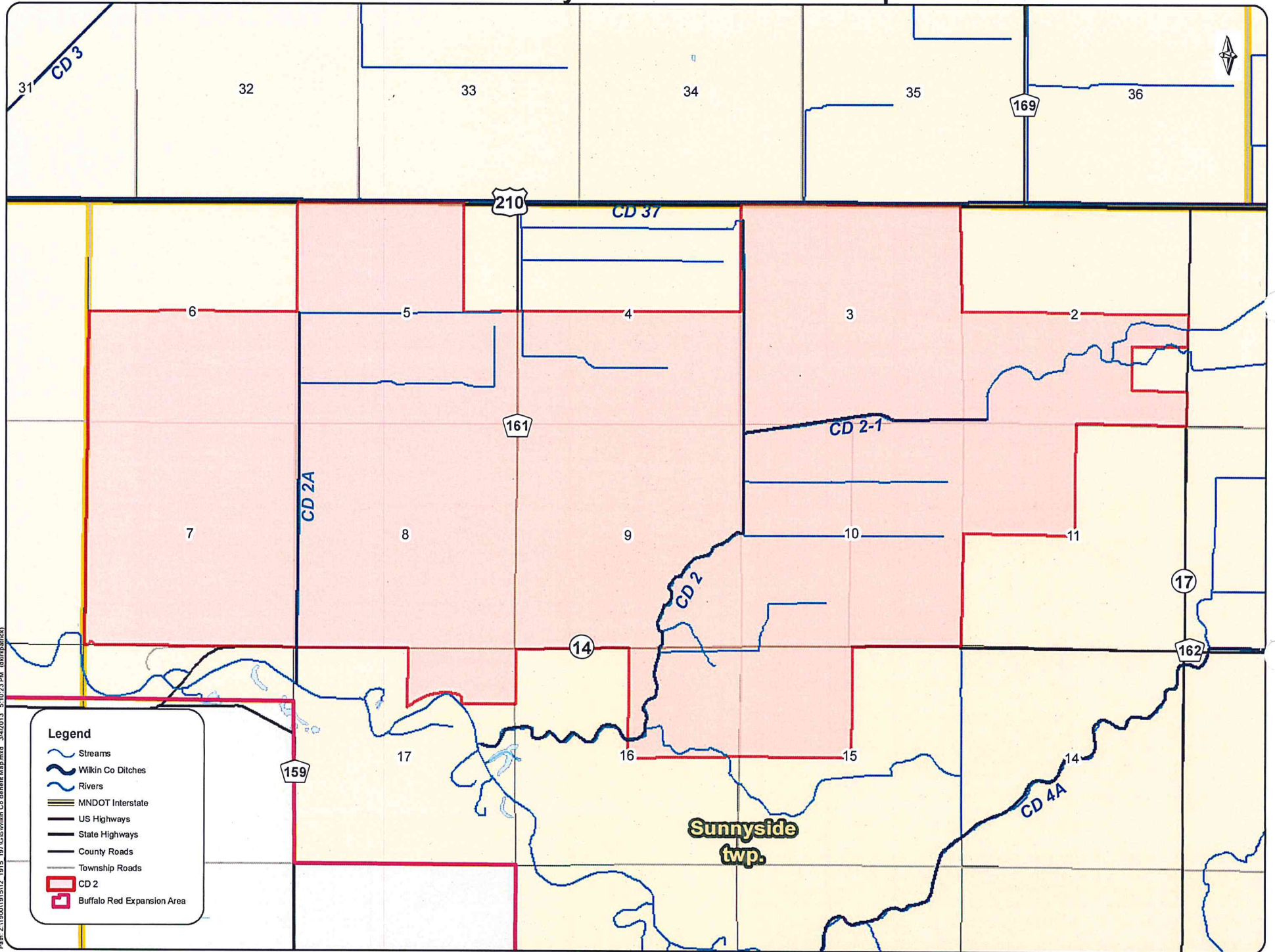


Wilkin County Ditch No. 2 Benefit Map

WHEREAS, Petition dated the 6th day of February, 1990 was filed with the Wilkin County Auditor by Eugene Moore, said petition requesting that the County Board of Commissioners allow the lands listed as follows:

178.56 Acres in S $\frac{1}{2}$ South of Railroad
Section 1, Township 132, Range 46

to drain into Wilkin Ditch NO. 2 and that said lands be assessed benefits for the same, and

WHEREAS, The Wilkin County Board of Commissioners has jurisdiction of this ditch system, and

WHEREAS, the Wilkin County Board of Commissioners held a hearing on the 12th day of April, 1990 pursuant to written notice to all of the land owners currently benefited by said system, and

WHEREAS, at said hearing, Thomas Richels, the duly appointed ditch authority, along with all interested landowners were given the opportunity to present their views, and the Wilkin County Board of Commissioners having heard no opposition to this petition regarding the benefits to be assessed against said lands to use said ditch as an outlet; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Wilkin County Board of Commissioners hereby order that said lands described herein shall hereby be added as benefited areas to the Wilkin County Ditch No. 2 with an outlet fee of \$445.00, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said lands be assessed in the amount of \$3.75 per acre for benefits for future assessments to said ditch.
